### ***BODY WORLDS: Animal Inside Out***

The following provisions shall apply for the artist or art student(s):

1. The Institute for Plastination ("IfP") shall grant the artist/art student(s) the permission to make drawings, and sketches ("works") in the exhibition using dry media, i.e. chalk and pencil.
2. The works are to be used exclusively in private or study context. Any other use of the works, such as book illustrations, advertising activities, Internet pages, in art galleries or any other commercial or public purposes shall be subject to the prior written consent of the IfP.
3. The IfP leaves it at the artist's discretion to present copies of his/her works and to conclude a separate agreement with the IfP, should the IfP be interested in using them.
4. Irrespective of these provisions, the IfP invites artists to provide the IfP with copies of the works, which will be used exclusively for internal documentation, within two weeks. Copies can be submitted to BODY WORLDS Office at [pressoffice@bodyworlds.com](mailto:pressoffice@bodyworlds.com)
5. Should the exhibition galleries become too crowded or should artists get in the way of other guests, the artist may be asked to stop drawing or sketching.
6. Should the artist / student fail to comply with this agreement, he/she shall undertake to pay a contractual penalty of up to US \$5,000, to the IfP. This penalty does not apply if the artist / student acted guiltlessly. This contractual penalty will fall due even if the IfP should ascertain at a later point in time that the information provided was incorrect.
